

## Cloverdale Health Care District Ambulance Membership Program

Membership Alliance Program with REACH/CALSTAR



The Cloverdale Health Care District is offering residents an ambulance membership to help offset the high costs of emergency ambulance transportation. Insurance companies routinely do not pay the entire amount of ambulance transportation, leaving the patient with the responsibility of paying the balance of the bill. The purpose of the membership is to cover the amount not covered by your insurance provider or Medicare. For \$50 per year, per household membership, (\$100 combined) you will never have to worry about paying an ambulance/air bill.

Medi-Cal Recipients are not eligible for this program.

**2017 Ambulance Membership will begin MARCH 1, 2017 Applications are accepted year round but expire last day February of each year.**

**Program Summary: Covers the unpaid portion of your ambulance/air insurance claim for services rendered**

- You must have insurance to participate- *this is not an insurance plan*
- Cost is \$50.00 per calendar year (\$100 COMBINED), renewed annually.
- Covers all immediate family members of the household that reside at the place of residence WITHIN the Cloverdale Health Care District-includes applicant, spouse/partner and children under the age of 26.
- The membership saves out of pocket expense for emergency ambulance/air transportation by paying the amount not covered by health care insurance, Kaiser, Blue Cross/Shield, Medicare etc., and other supplemental medical insurance.
- Provides the needed insurance information to expedite billing.
- The plan covers you from March 1 to February 28 of the enrollment year.
- Household members must be on application prior to a response or transport to be an active member
