### **Cloverdale Health Care District** Meeting Minutes-July 13, 2020 (No meeting in June)

## Meeting agenda was approved by all board members with no changes.

**Previous Minutes:** Minutes of the May 11, 2020 meeting were approved unanimously after a motion to approve was put forward by board member DeMartini.

**Financial Statement for June, 2020-**The financials were approved unanimously after Tom explained the PPP monies and payroll/benefit expenditures were posted to a separate ledger.

**Manager's Report:** There were no operational, equipment or workers comp issues. There were 40 transports, with a cumulative two month drop in revenues of about 60%.

**Draft Budget:** The board asked Tom to prepare a pro-forma budget for the board's approval at a future meeting. It will include IGT monies for 18 months.

**Review subordination request by Cloverdale Community Development Successor Agency:** The board agreed to take no action which will result in the subordination being approved by default.

**District's Attorney-**Robert Marmor, the district's current attorney is closing his practice. The board agreed to seek legal advice on an as needed basis.

**November Election 2020-**Board members Hanchett and Winter have expiring terms. They are both in the process of preparing the forms which need to be emailed to the county election office as no face to face visits to prepare forms will take place due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

For the Good of the Order: Current Covid-19 situation in Cloverdale was generally discussed. Nothing else was submitted.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:25 p.m. The next meeting is Monday, August 10, 2020.

#### STAFF REPORT September 2020

#### Manager Report-

August was a bit of a challenging month. Two rigs suffered mechanical issues, leaving us to respond out of the third rig (backup). Both units came back from the shop by the end of the affected week. The main unit went back into the shop after about a week to try and solve an intermittent problem.

We continue to back staff positions for fire personnel dedicated to fire strike teams. All shifts are covered.

We assigned online mandatory sexual harassment training to all staff as required by law. We have engaged the instructors for our biannual EMT refresher course to be held in December. The annual audit has begun and the onsite testing is scheduled for October  $6^{\text{th}}$ .

COVID- Our area has had an increase in the population of people testing positive. There is an ongoing outbreak at Cloverdale Health Care Center (CHCC). We have transported 4 patients who have tested positive and have had acute symptoms. All were from the CHCC. We have not transported any patients from the general population. The Sonoma Department of Health has a notification process in place to notify responder agencies when a positive COVID patient is transported. All of our notifications resulted from the CHCC and were already know to us. All staff assumes all patient contacts are COVID positive and we have a 100% compliance rate with PPE usage and no exposure events.

#### BUDGET FY 20-21

Personnel- Budget figures and changes. With the increased IGT funding expected to continue into at least the next FY, additional funds are available for ambulance replacement and operational needs. The FY 20-21 budget reflects the continued one (1) FTE EMT position approved last year. The wages and benefits line has been changed for several sub-items. The three existing wage bases have a 3% requested increase. The part-time EMT wages have been balanced out for an over the year average which is now known and an increase in the per diem rate for part-time paramedics is included also.

Income- The parcel tax assessment and the Prop 13 funds are accounted for. We will be increasing our billed base rate by \$100 per transport to help realize more income and increase our basis for IGT funding.

Expense- One new line item was added to reflect the outsourcing of our website hosting and maintenance. We have engaged Streamline to develop a regulatory compliant website. Streamline is the preferred provider for the Special Districts Risk Management Association. The budget reflects increases that we are aware of including Cloverdale Dispatch fees, payroll tax increases, expected COLA to outside services, and products-3 % Adjustments to line items have increased or decrease reflective of the prior year's actual expenditures.

Capital- We have included additional funds in the capital equipment line item to reflect the purchase of the third generation of our patient transport gurney. That cost was \$12,000 with options. We will use our Workers Compensation dividend to help with the purchase.

Outlook- Management is confident the increased QAF reimbursement of Medi-Cal will continue, the IGT program will continue through the end of the calendar year 2020. The District will remain in a good fiscal condition with funds still being dedicated to ambulance replacement and reserve accounts.

Election- No election- Hanchett, and Winter appointed.
